School Safety

Your child's safety is top priority here at Solomon. This is evident from this week's practice drills. Please take advantage of this week's awareness to talk your child about other safety precautions that may keep them safe. For example, talk to them about not talking to or approaching strangers, staying away from moving vehicles, how to cross the street correctly, your family fire plan, etc. While we may think our children know this, why not take a moment to review it again? It could save their life or prevent an injury.

For the safety of our children, please adhere to our arrival and departure procedures. In the morning, if you are walking your child into the building, please do not park along the Cherry Street entrance. This is a no parking zone. They may not wait outside the building. Inside they are supervised by the teacher on "bus duty." While these requests may inconvenience you, the children's safety is an important consideration.
