Thursday, March 26th performance is scheduled at 7:00 pm. Children should report to his or her classroom at 6:45 pm, no earlier. Doors to the building will be unlocked at 6:30 pm. If you arrive before 6:45 pm, please keep your child with you until it is time to report to the classrooms. Children in grades preschool - 3rd may be picked up in the classrooms after the performance. Children in 4th - 6th can be greeted in the lobby.

Sunday, March 29th performance is scheduled for the 10:30 am service. Students should report to the classrooms at 10:15 am. Sunday school begins at 9:20 am for those that would like to attend.
