4<sup>th</sup> Grade - Kitchen Update

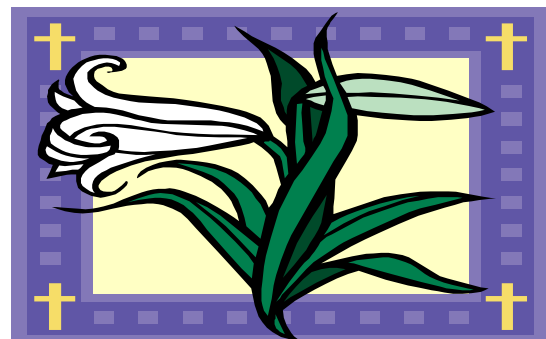
5<sup>th</sup> Grade - OSU

## Summer Child Care and Camps

What is your child doing this summer? Do you remember the phrase, "Mom, I'm bored, there's nothing to do!" We have the answer for you!

Solomon will again be offering full time child care for children that have completed Kindergarten through the 6<sup>th</sup> grade and five camps. Care begins at 7:15 am and ends at 5:30 pm. Children enjoy safe and structured programming here at Solomon. The children have the opportunity to swim at the Woodville Pool several times each week, take trips to the library, parks and other local areas of interest. Care is \$22/day and includes the camp activities. There is a \$15 registration fee.

The five camps being offered are: Adventure Camp, Camp Celebration, Cooking Camp, M.A.D. (music, art and drama) Camp and Astro Camp. Camps are one week each from 9:00 am - noon. Camp fees range from \$30 -\$40 for the week. Preschool children may attend the camps.

## Achievement Tests

The children in grades 3 through 6 will be taking Ohio Achievement Tests beginning April 20. Each class will take the reading and math portions. In addition, the 4<sup>th</sup> grade will take a writing section and the 5<sup>th</sup> grade will take science and social studies portions. Help your child do well on these tests by:

- Getting a good night's rest before the test.
- Having a light, healthy breakfast.
- Dress comfortably and arrive on time.
- Give words of praise, "You'll do great!"
- Tell your child to relax.
- Remind your child to read directions and look at all the answers before choosing one.
- Remind them to check answers before turning in his or her test.
- Please try not to schedule trips or appointments for test days.
