Recycling Fundraiser

Solomon Lutheran School has some exciting news!! We've just joined the Global Re-Source Funding recycling program. This program is free and provides convenient locations for collecting toner/laser cartridges, iPods, laptops, inkjet cartridges, digital cameras, GPS devices and used cell phones while raising funds for our school.

How the program works: Collection boxes, clearly marked and accessible, will be placed at the Cherry Street entrance. You can drop off your recyclable cell phones, iPods, and cartridges whenever it's convenient for you. Laptops should be taken to the church/school office. Periodically, we will ship the items collected to the Global Re-Source Funding offices, at no cost to us. Global Re-Source Funding will then issue us checks for those items sent in!!!

Did you know that every second of every day nine ink cartridges are thrown away? Help us turn this waste into money for our school! Please donate your cell phones, iPods, digital cameras, GPS devices and cartridges. Parents- would you consider asking others in your workplace to collect and donate these used items as well? You could be the contact person and bring these items in for Solomon to recycle.

Not only is this an easy way to raise funds, but it also teaches valuable lessons about the variety of materials that can be recycled and helps develop life long patterns of recycling.
